

PROCEEDING OF RESEARCH EXTENSION INTERFACE MEETING OF KVK, NAYAGARH FOR THE MONTH OF JANUARY'17

The Research Extension Interface meeting of KVK, Nayagarh was held on dt.17.01.2017 at the conference hall of KVK under the chairmanship of S.J.K.N. Jena, DDA, Nayagarh. S.J.Arindam Dakua, Collector & District Magistrate, Nayagarh also attended the meeting as Chief Guest. As desired by the Collector & District Magistrate, the Sr.Scientist & Head presented a brief report on ARYA. At first, the SS & H briefed about the purpose of conducting R-E meeting every month. Later, he also presented the Action Taken Report for the month of December'16 and activities to be undertaken for the month of January'17 by the KVK.

ATR for the month of December 16

- Beneficiary selection for FLD programme on “Sugarcane stripper” has been started at Raghunathpur village involving of 13 no. of beneficiary (Scientist – Ag.Engg.)
- Sowing of greengram by Zero till drill has been conducted at Petapalli village & Pulse Research centre, Nayagarh. (Scientist – Ag.Engg.)
- FLD program on IDM for seed & seedling blight has been done at Dhenkena village in an area of 1ha.involving 10no. of beneficiary. (Scientist-PP)
- Insecticides like Imidachlopid, Acetamiprid, abamectin, Dimethoate & neem oil etc are distributed for thrips management in chilli of Dhanchangada, beguniapatna village in an area of 0.5 ha involving 7 nos of beneficiary. (Scientist-PP)
- FLD on hopper type Paddy Winnower has been done at Balugaon village of Nayagarh block. (Scientist – Home Sc.)
- Beneficiary selection for OFT on Performance of Bypass fact has been done in Katrajhari, Raghunathpur of Odagon block, Bankasalia, Guptapalli, Itamati, Beguniapatana, Nuakantabania of Nayagarh. (Scientist –Fishery Sc)
- Beneficiary selection for FLD on integration in fish pond has been started in Rupapalli at Khandapada block & Balugaon of Nayagarh block. (Scientist –Fishery Sc.)
- OFT on rearing of meat purpose poultry bird (Pallishree) in backyard has been conducted in module villages (Erundipathara, Anlamada and Darpanarayanpur). (Scientist – Home Sc.)
- Distribution of backyard poultry Banaraja has been done to popularize the breed among the farmers. (Scientist –Fishery Sc)
- Beneficiary selection for OFT on Oyster mushroom has been started. (Scientist – Home Sc.)

Collector and DM, Nayagarh

Sj. Arindam Dakua, Collector- cum DM enquired about the approved enterprises (mushroom/backyard poultry/stunted fingerlings) and stressed upon the effective work under these enterprises. He also added to conduct all the programmes in convergence mode with the line departments.

In this context, the SS & H discussed about the chosen programmes which are implemented in convergence mode with respective line depts. of the district (fishery/Animal husbandry/horticulture).

Further, he suggested to conduct district level workshop in the month of February, 2017. He also advised to take the help of D.S.M.S., ORMAS, Nayagarh for marketing.

DDA, Nayagarh

Sj.K.N.Jena, DDA, Nayagarh discussed on the demonstration of rabi pulses with Tarm 1, IPM 2-3 and IPM-02-14 in different blocks of the district. Yellow vein mosaic virus is the common disease in greengram & he requested to the concerned KVK scientist for stage by stage observation of the crop (greengram) so that the disease can be controlled in a better way. He also suggested for the application of bio-pesticide Btk @ 1kg/ha to control greengram pod borer. Under PMKSY (Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchai Yojana), an area of 500 acre has been covered with sunflower cultivation. He highlighted that the crop is getting spoiled by parrot menace. He suggested the farmers to cultivate 5 acres of land at least in one chaka. After harvest, the sunflower seeds will be procured by NAFED.

He also added that, groundnut of different varieties have been distributed in 8 blocks of the district. Total 550 no. of minikits @ 20kg/kit has also been distributed in Odagaon and Nuagaon blocks under the NMOOP programme. He also requested to the KVK scientists to recommend need based fungicides to control over various diseases.

RRTTS, BBSR

Smt.A.Sasmal, Sr.Scientist, RRTTS, BBSR suggested for spraying of thiamethoxam @ 3gm/10ltr of water (150gm/ha) within 30 days of sowing of pulses. She also suggested to adopt IPM methods in greengram and installation of yellow sticky traps for the management of white fly in pulses. She also advocated for practicing bee keeping (var.indica) in the mustard and sunflower fields to increase the oil content as well as for effective pollination.

SRS, Nayagarh

Dr.P.K.Nayak, OIC, SRS, Nayagarh discussed regarding a new variety of sugarcane (Charchika) in which sucrose content is 17.5%.


Activities to be started in the month of Jan'16 of KVK, Nayagarh

- Beneficiary selection for OFT on integrated measures for melon fruit fly in bittergourd will be started. (Scientist-PP)


- Beneficiary selection for FLD on “Quality gur preparation” will be started (Scientist – Ag.Engg.)
