PROCEEDING OF RESEARCH EXTENSION INTERFACE MEETING OF KVK, NAYAGARH FOR THE MONTH OF SEPTEMBER, 2017

The Research Extension Interface meeting for the month of September'17 was held at O/O DDA, Nayagarh on Dt 20.09.2017 at 3.30 PM under the chairmanship of DDA, Nayagarh. All the line deptt. officials and the scientists along with SS&H of KVK were present in the meeting.

The Sr. Scientist & Head presented the **Action Taken Report** (ATR) of KVK for the month of August'17 & the action plan for the month of Sept'17.

Activities to be undertaken for the month of Sep'17

DDA, Nayagarh

Sj.S.K.Panda, DDA, Nayagarh advised to introduce new var. of oilseed & pulse crops in the rabi season. He also suggested to focus on the market linkage of the produce.

SS&H

The SS & H informed regarding the demonstration of YMV tolerant greengram var. IPM 02-14 under cluster demonstration program of KVK during rabi 2016-17.

ARD, Nayagarh

Nodal Officer, ARD., Nayagarh discussed about the dairy programme i.e. a scheme launched by the Govt. named Dairy Enterpreneurship Development scheme (DEDS). Under the scheme, dairy farms & OMFED milk parlour have been sponsored.

Plant protection, KVK

Mr. T. K. Ray, Scientist, plant Protection discussed about the CIMMYT scheme on SRMO project implemented in Nayagarh. Under this programme, 2 nos. of maize hybrids (OMH 14-27, CAH 15-11) distributed among 30 farmers and a successful OFT has been conducted in association with Scientist, (CIMMYT) and of line deptt. Officials in village namely Krushnaprasad of Nuagaon block.

He also mentioned that BPH is the emerging pest this year in Nayagarh district. The farmers are advised for early sowing and alley cropping and alternate spraying of buprofenzin & thiomethoxam. Sheath blight is another major disease in paddy cultivation. Therefore, the farmers are advised to go for summer ploughing and important spraying of Trifloxy strobin and Tebuconazol (mixed fungicides) to control sheath blight of paddy.

DDH, Nayagarh

DDH, Nayagarh discussed on cashew cultivation covering an area of 305.30ha mango cultivation 12.7 ha, K lime of 12.8 ha area and oil palm covering 143.20 ha area under MGNRGS programme.

Under MIDH scheme, mango covered area of 72.6 ha whereas cashew cultivated in 155.7 ha in Nayagarh district.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks by the Sr. Scientist & Head to all the members present in

the meeting.
